Given the Law 30.12.2010, n. 240, and in particular the art. 22;

Given the D.R. no. 5389 of 12.28.2020, with which the "Regulations for the awarding of research grants" were lastly amended;

Given the D.R. no. 5698 of 23.12.2022 with which it is announced, among others, for the scientific - disciplinary area HISTORICAL, PHILOSOPHICAL, PEDAGOGICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SCIENCES n. 1 public selection aimed at the assignment of n. 2 research grants (1 year) for the program referred to in n. 47 of Annex A of the notice in question;

Considering that the Scientific Responsible has asked to ban the procedure requesting the master's degree of the class LM-84 Scienze storiche;

Having regard to the reasoned request to the Rector of the Scientific Responsible who, in order to guarantee the widest participation in the selection, requires that qualifications and access requirements be added, in addition to the master's degree of class LM-84 Scienze storiche, the following degree classes deemed consistent with the profile being researched:

Laurea magistrale delle classi LM-1 Antropologia culturale ed etnologia, LM-5 Archivistica e biblioteconomia, LM-14 Filologia moderna, LM-80 Scienze geografiche.

HEREBY DECREES

1. Research program no. 47 of which Annex A of the tender D.R. no. 5698 of 12.23.2022, mentioned in the introduction, is supplemented in the sense that in addition to the LM-84 Scienze storiche, the following degree classes are added:

Laurea magistrale delle classi LM-1 Antropologia culturale ed etnologia, LM-5 Archivistica e biblioteconomia, LM-14 Filologia moderna, LM-80 Scienze geografiche.

- 2. The remaining provisions of D.R. remain unchanged. no. 5698 of 23.12.2022, including the deadline for the submission of applications, set by art. 3, paragraph 2.
- 3. This rectification decree is made public electronically through the computer register set up on the institutional website of the University.

Title: "Environmental history and shared use of agro-sylvi-pastoral resources: conflicts and oral history, statistics and demography in the European mountain (18th-21st c.)" (Progetto ERC Stg 2019 - ANTIGONE).

Description: The fellowship will be part of the research project ANTIGONE which investigates the process of marginalisation of European mountains since the 18th c. studying how sharing practices to manage environmental resources changed. The fellow will carry out autonomous investigation of environmental history studying, on the case studies (particularly French Pyrenees and Sierra Nevada), documentation about conflicts on rights of access to environmental resources, statistical enquiries about on agro-forestry -pastoral resources management, demographic historical series in local and central archives, as well as through oral enquiries. He/she will manage data base & GIS platforms and elaborate data with an analytical perspective and deep temporality, to grasp the relationships between phenomena and traces in the ways to share environmental resources.
