

GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING INTO A COTUTELLE AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS WHOSE HOME INSTITUTION IS THE UNIVERSITA' DEGLI STUDI DI GENOVA

At the Università di Genova is possible to enter into a cotutelle agreement, namely enter into a convention between the Università di Genova and a foreign University aimed at obtaining a double title.

In order to enter into a cotutelle agreement, the following requirements are needed:

- The student must be enrolled at a Phd course at the Università di Genova
- The agreement must be concluded within the end of the second year of enrollment
- The student must spend at least 6 months, also not continuous, at both Universities
- The teaching committee of the course of the Università di Genova will have to deliver a favourable opinion concerning the cotutorship, attesting the compatibility and equivalence of the programmes of the two courses and its scientific validity. A similar decision shall be borne by the competent body of the foreign University
- At the end of the course, in case of positive outcome of the final exam, the academic qualification of doctor of philosophy of the Università di Genova will be awarded. The cotutelle agreement will be also mentioned.
- First of all, the student must inform his/her supervisor of the will to conclude an agreement

Students enrolled in a foreign University can contact the Ufficio Dottorati to be informed of the modalities to conclude the agreement.
