Philipp Wüdrich lives and works in Munich and Milan. He got his degrees in architecture from the TU Berlin and the Accademia di architettura di Mendrisio and works independent since 2012. His first works together with Alexander Tochtermann were nominated for the BDA max40 Award 2016 and the DAM Award for German architecture in 2017. He is a licensed architect in Munich and was appointed to the BDA Bund Deutscher Architekten in 2019.

He was invited as a critic and to lecture in Germany and other European countries. Since 2011 he was teaching architectural design in various universities like the Politecnico di Milano and the Accademia di Mendrisio and was guest professor at the Munich Academy of Fine Arts.
