Having several laboratories located in different European cities, communication represents a fundamental activity that is also at the basis of technical development.

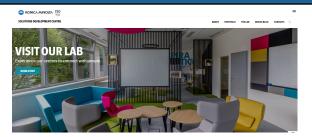

Within Konica Minolta, as R&D Communication Manager, I coordinate the development and execution of an **integrated communication plan.** My responsibilities include:

- In agreement with our Deputy CTOs, every year we identify a set of **key performance indicators** and the **communication targets** that constitute the basis for the development of a communication strategy. KPIs and targets are strongly dependent on the overall corporate strategy and within the last years we had to shift from more research and abstract vision to a more values and business oriented approach.
- I have developed the website for Konica Minolta Laboratory Europe and a one-page website for Konica Minolta Laboratory USA. Recently the two web pages were updated and combined into a unique DX Solutions Development Centre website.
- I have managed the content strategy for our company's Genius Blog and the press releases about Konica Minolta R&D announcements. Coordinating external agencies, I have developed the **communication materials** of the group (presentations, rollups, brochures, gadgets for events) and I have managed the publications of the whitepapers.
- I have coordinated the participation of our laboratory into **many international events** (Al Summit of London and New York) showcasing our results and prototypes.
- I am responsible for the development of an **internal newsletter** and of All Hands meetings to keep teams' members informed and engaged.
- I manage **social media** (Linkedin, and Youtube) that are used as a support for sharing the messages at the basis of our communication strategy.
- I conceived and coordinated the creation of a set of short videos 'AI Pills' focusing on presenting some of the research activities and projects developed within the lab (videos are available in the Konica Minolta Global R&D's Youtube channel).
- I support the team in identifying appropriate channels for technical and scientific publications.
- I am managing **internal communication**, to ensure that members of the teams (who are growing fast and in several different European locations) are kept engaged and updated with laboratories' activities. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 lock-down I started recording and editing a set of video interviews to our colleagues to keep the team engaged and to support sharing of good spirit among the laboratories.

Within the Industrial Innovation Division, I worked as a Project Manager coordinating or supporting the coordination of several European funded projects on ICT applied to energy efficiency. I was managing both technical and dissemination activities.
